## SCA Uniform Dress Code

The new dress code for the 2010-2011 school year will be school uniforms. The detailed list is posted on our website, [www.SalemChristianAcademy.com](http://www.SalemChristianAcademy.com). Please pay special attention to the knee length requirement of dresses, skirts and shorts. Land's End and French Toast brands have items labeled knee length. School Uniform clothing is specially designed without markings, logos or cargo pockets. Uniform items can be purchased from any store, catalog, or school supply company such as J. C. Penney, Lands' End (also sold at Sears), Casson, etc., as long as it meets the SCA Uniform Dress Code. Some stores such as Target, Meijers and Walmart may carry uniform items seasonally, but it is unknown if they will carry knee length items.

Spirit Wear items will be available for sale, and may be worn at designated times during the school year. Order forms will be available on line and at the SCA office.
